Summary report (till 11 th April 2013) for the progress of Community Led Total Sanitation campaign in four districts

State programme management unit, Drinking Water and Sanitation Department, Jharkhand launched Community Led Total Sanitation Campaign in October 2012 under Nirmal Bharat Abhiyan. The campaign was executed in four districts viz. Ranchi, Ramgarh, Khunti, Lohardaga as a pilot project. The proposed target, selection against target and the activity done till April 2013 together with number of ODF villages achieved during the campaign is given in Annexure 1. A summary of the list of ODF villages in four districts is given in Annexure 2. A summary of the cost incurred in CLTS campaign during the period October 2012 to March 2013 is given in Annexure 3. The detailed list of overall Blocks, Panchayats and Villages where CLTS activities were performed is given in Annexure 4. Annexure 5 shows how the people initiated the sanitation campaign with a mass movement to prepare dry latrines accompanied by enthusiastic ODF celebrations. Media houses also supported this movement.

At many villages people opined that the cost was only their effort and the waste material of their house.
